Plan to Address Learning Loss

Vista Meadows Academy

Programming:

Vista Meadows Academy plans to use the 98c Learning Loss Grant to address learning loss by utilizing learning opportunities and educational opportunities within the metro-Detroit area. Educational experiential field trips to museums and the holocaust center will be used to reinforce the learning of subjects and concepts within a real-world setting. The DIA and the African American History Museum will strengthen the students tangible connection with the concepts being taught with in the classrooms. Other opportunities may arise one month that presents a unique learning experience that I have not foreseen in this proposal.

Implementation Timeline:

The timeline for the Learning Loss Program will start in February. We will have one experiential learning event that ties into the classroom instruction 4 times throughout the year. The total of experiential learning events will be 4.

Metrics Used to Evaluate the Program:

The metrics used to evaluate our program will be teacher / classroom-based projects and tests. Each teacher will create a rubric that will measure the learning of the field trip and an outcome-based project or test summarization from the knowledge gained from the experience.

Estimated Costs:

Estimated cost for bus transportation for up to 5 hours for 100 students and 8 staff, \$340.00 per bus. 2 busses will be needed for each trip, the total cost for two busses will be approx. \$680.00 per trip. Admission to museums and learning environments will vary depending on the educational venue. The average cost per student will be \$10 dollars per student. The cost for all 4 trips will be approx. \$2,720.

Our total cost for museum and event entry will be \$10 per student times 4 events. Total cost for entry for all 4 events will be \$2000.

Our total for all school events will be \$4,720.
